Keep Storm Drains Clear

With the approach of Fall and cooler weather comes more rain and falling leaves. Here are a few tips on how to protect our environment and keep our streets clear.

- Avoid placing trash and recyclables directly on drains and inlets.
- Do not rake leaves and yard debris into the street or alley.
- Remove all trash and loose items that could potentially interfere with storm drainage from your street gutters and alleys.
