Approval of Minutes:

Old Business:

New Business:

- The committee received a nomination for a landscape award at 46 Angela Drive for the Fall Landscaping.
- The committee nominated 239 Mark Court for the Halloween Decoration winner.
- Kristy to email Kelli for placement of signs prior to the week of Halloween.
- With remaining grant left to use at Stockslager's the committee discussed ways to utilize the funding prior to its expiration.
 - Pre-order small poinsettia's to donate to Germantown businesses on behalf of the CBC.
 - Pre-order winter foliage such as winter cabbage to plant around city buildings.
 - Purchase decorations to be placed in the city buildings.
 - Purchase decorations to be placed on the Christmas tree pots that are placed around town.
- Discussion of upcoming options for community events: Christmas in the Park, Christmas scavenger hunts, painted rocks with special savings for Germantown businesses.
- Next meeting will need to be a work session to check out all trees and wreaths prior to their placement in town. May need to purchase new strands of lights for some trees.

Next meeting is scheduled for November 16 for a work session at the city garage to prepare Christmas tree pots..
