The City of Germantown Council met in work session on December 4, 2023 at 7:41 p.m. in the City Building Council Chambers.

BUSINESS:

Traffic Engineer – speed limit on Market and 4 way Stop on Market

Mike Hafner with TEC Engineering, the City’s Traffic Engineer, reviewed the proposed idea of installing a 4 way stop at Market Street and Main Street. After a lengthy discussion Mr. Hafner suggested that it would advise against the installation of the 4 way.

Solid waste grant for playground equipment at Hillcrest Park

Staff and Council discussed the awarded grant to install equipment at Hillcrest Park. If this is accepted the Park Board Budget would be more in debt to the General Fund. This will be discussed with the Park Board to see if they would like to proceed with the project.

Adult Use Cannabis Control Discussion

Staff and Council discussed the new legislation that was passed at the State level legalizing recreational cannabis use. Staff will create legislation putting a moratorium on this for the January meeting.
