Improvements were recently completed by the City on our historic covered bridge. While there is still more work yet to be done, the fresh coat of paint on the railing and gables really make our landmark shine. Look for more major improvements in the near future. The City also recently concluded an enhancement project at the Hillcrest Park shelter. The shelter received its own fresh coat of paint after the completion of some much needed repairs. We hope that the people of Germantown can get out and enjoy these community assets as we transition into some beautiful autumn weather.

## Grant Awarded for Kercher Park Bike Path



In 2021, the City of Germantown applied for a grant through the MVRPC (Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission) in order to improve our bike path along Twin Creek. The City is happy to announce that it has been awarded a 100% grant, totaling \$96,099.00, which will overlay the 1.7 mile bike path in Kercher Park with new asphalt. ODOT (the Ohio Department of Transportation) will be responsible for the bidding of the project which is set to begin in January, 2024 and to be completed later the same year. This project will greatly enhance the path for the many people who take advantage of this amenity.



## New Water Tower




Construction has been completed on the new water tower on Weaver Rd. Construction began on this project in the fall of 2020. The City has been hard at work from the start, and the final product was finished this June. This was a multistep undertaking which the City completed including excavating the land, erecting the new structure, and completing installation of a new SCADA

(Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) System is a computerized system that will help to prevent maintenance issues and streamline operations. In short, it will help ensure the people of Germantown are receiving high quality water from our new tower! The final touches are being put into place and should be finished next month. Once they are, the old tower will be demolished as the new tower will be fully functioning.
