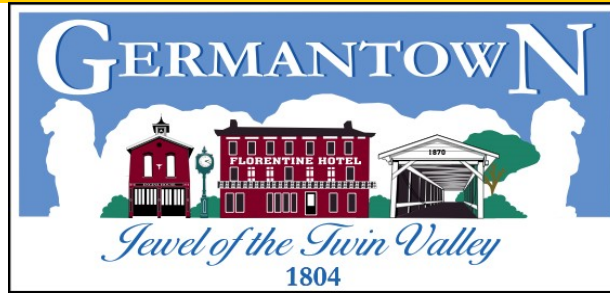

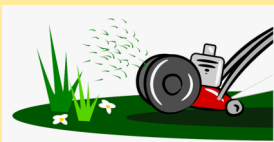
Come Out and Enjoy the July 4th Parade!

Water & Sewer Rate Adjustment

The new utility rates are \$22.32/3,000 gallons Water and \$14.34/1,000 gallons Sewer. The new rates went into effect April 1, 2022

New Waste Collection Contract Approved.



The City has negotiated and approved a new 3 year contract with Rumpke for residential collection service from July 1, 2022 thru June 30, 2025. In order to correspond with the Rumpke increase, the new monthly rates will be \$17.88/unit. The monthly fee for the toter will be reduced from \$3.10 to \$2.50.



New Storm Water Rates


To keep up with storm water maintenance, improvements and drainage projects, new storm water rates will increase by \$0.50. The new rate of \$4.00 has taken effect April 1, 2022.
