The Municipality of Germantown Council met in work session on September 17, 2012 at 7:43 p.m. in the Municipal Building Council Chambers.

Dumpster Enclosures

Council reviewed the dumpster enclosure information that the Law Director had handed out. It was determined that at this time Council would not make any changes to the current Ordinance regarding dumpster enclosures.

Proposed Tank located at the Veterans Memorial Museum

Council discussed the proposed tank located on Main Street at the Veterans Memorial Museum. Mrs. Sizemore stated that the staff has sent out letters to the neighbors of the museum as Council had asked and only one neighbor directly across the street has responded to the letter and she was not in favor of having the tank in the neighborhood.

It was determined that Council would like to see additional information regarding the tank and would like to see a site plan showing exactly where the tank would be located on the property.

Other Business

Mrs. Sizemore and Council discussed a proposed restaurant locating in the City. The owner of the restaurant has asked to have tax abatement and would like Council to consider this request. Council asked that the Manager provide them with more information and they would be able to discuss the matter at that time.

Mr. Koogle asked if the Manager would have a traffic study done in the City to try to alleviate the backups that occur.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Mr. Koogle moved to adjourn the meeting.
