

## MUNICIPALITY OF GERMANTOWN COUNCIL

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 13

The Municipality of Germantown Council met in work session on November 4, 2013 at 7:29 p.m. in the Municipal Building Council Chambers.

### **MEMBERS PRESENT:**

### **Landscaping Business**

Mrs. Sizemore reviewed the proposed legislation regarding landscape businesses located in the Municipality. The consensus of Council was to move forward with the proposed legislation.

### **Peddlers, Vendors, Canvassers and Charitable Solicitations**

The Law Director reviewed the proposed legislation regarding Peddlers, Vendors, Canvassers and Charitable Solicitations. The consensus of Council was to move forward with the proposed legislation.

### **Unclaimed Money**

Mrs. Sizemore explained that the State Auditors have recommended that the proposed legislation be set in place regarding unclaimed money. After a brief discussion the consensus of Council was to move forward with the proposed legislation.

### **Veterans Memorial**

Mrs. Sizemore shared examples of a proposed granite bench that the Twin Valley Heritage Foundation would like to purchase and donate to the City for the Veterans Memorial in Veterans Park. She explained that they would have a few minor changes to the proposed bench design. The consensus of Council was that this would be a great addition to the Veterans Memorial but would like to see a site plan with the location of the bench.

### **Other Business**

Mr. Boeder questioned the process of how NIC handles cases such as peeling paint. He questioned who is reviewing these cases.

The Law Director explained the process. NIC generates the initial paperwork/notices, certified letters and photographs, then he along with Lisa at NIC, work together through the court process. After it has gone before the Judge, the Probation Department should be monitoring the progress.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Mr. Johnson moved to adjourn the meeting.
