Tornado Siren Information

Tornado Sirens are an *outdoor* warning system designed to alert those who are outside that something dangerous is approaching. When the sirens sound, vou should go inside and tune to local media to get more information and be prepared to take shelter quickly. Be prepared ahead of time and develop

a safety plan for you and your family. Planning ahead can lower the chance of injury or death in the event severe weather strikes. It is recommended that every home and business have a NOAA weather radio. This device is like a smoke detector for severe weather, and it can

wake you up when a warning is issued in your area so you can take appropriate action.
Germantown's tornado sirens are tested the first Monday of each month at noon. (as long as the threat of severe weather does not exist)

July 4– Independence Day No Delays.

September 7-Labor Day No Collection on Labor Day. Schedule for entire week moves back one day.

October 12 -Columbus Day: No Delays.
