Chief Alldred went on by saying that in the month of June they did water safety with the pool employees and aerial operations.

Two members of the staff attended a LP gas training at Sugarcreek Fire Department. Both staff members stated that they learned a lot from the training.

We are having the Stryker EMS power load systems installed into each of the ambulances. This system will assist in securely lifting and loading patients into the ambulances. These were purchased for the department by Germantown Rescue Squad, Inc. and we are very thankful. He would like to have a demonstration for the committee and for Council.
