Additional Tornado Siren

Chief Alldred stated that he is looking into a grant that would pay for half of an additional Tornado siren. This siren would cover residents in the Township and the City and the location will be determined at a later date.

Council and the Trustees discussed the additional Tornado Siren. The consensus was that the cost would come from the Fire Fund.

Bicentennial Clock Repair

Mrs. Gilleland stated that Bicentennial Clock is in need of repair. It was installed in 2004 by both German and German Township. The repair cost could be approximately \$9,000.

Council and the Trustees discussed the Bicentennial Clock Repair. The consensus was that at this time Staff obtain additional estimates for repair.

Levy Discussion

Montgomery County Fair

The City Law Director explained that at this time the City cannot discuss the Montgomery County Fair Boards intentions.
