MONDAY, JUNE 4, 18

The City of Germantown Council met in work session on June 4, 2018 at 7:44 p.m. in the City Building Council Chambers.

Business:

Discussion of the Wetzel Property

Council, Staff and the Wetzel family discussed the various options of de-annexation from the City. Mr. Brane explained that the property was annexed several years back. The City and German Township had an agreement for the annexation to the City. He recommended that the Wetzel property remain in the City and the small piece of land, that is currently in German Township, be annexed into the City. This should have occurred during the original annexation years before. This would allow the Wetzel Family more flexibility if they choose to sell or divide the property. The Wetzel family will consider their options and make contact with the City Manager.

Discussion of Bike Path Parking Lot

Staff and Council discussed the bike path parking lot being used for events by a local business as their parking lot. This lot is designated for patrons using the bike path and closes at dusk. The excess traffic is causing congestion and complaints. The consensus of Council was to have the Law Director send a letter to the business explaining the concerns.

Other Business

Andrew Coy, local Boy Scout, 400 Lindell Drive, stated he is in the process of looking for a project to complete. He asked if the City has any community projects he would be able to do or assist with. Staff suggested that he make contact with the Parks Board for recommendations.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Mr. Kuhn moved to adjourn the meeting.

The work session was adjourned at 8:47 p.m.
