Business:

Discussion of Proposed Fire Station Project

Mr. Bob McClain provided Council with the history of Veteran Memorial Park (VMP) and his involvement. He would like to see that the proposed fire station not encroach into the Park and that a different location be considered. He explained that the VMP Committee would need to discuss the proposed request. Mr. McClain and Staff discussed VMP and the proposed Fire Department project. He provided handouts for Council to read regarding VMP's history.

Discussion of Installation of Manholes on Germantown Farmersville Pike

Mrs. Gilleland explained that there is a concern with Germantown Farmersville Pike sewer line. This sewer line on the west side of the street is a private line that was installed years ago and it causes many issues and backups. We are considering installing manholes in easements to assist with future backups. The consensus was for Staff to look further into installing manholes. They would like to see the Service Department have easier access.
