#### Keep Storm Drains Clear

With the approach of Fall and cooler weather comes more rain and falling leaves. Blocked storm water drains can lead to flooding in the street and pollution in our streams. Here are a few tips on how to be proactive about protecting our environment and helping keep our streets clear and Germantown beautiful.



- Avoid placing trash and recyclables directly on drains and inlets.
- When heavy rain is forecasted, place trash and recycling totes at the end of your driveway close to, but not in, the street to keep the gutter flow line clear.
- Do not rake leaves and yard debris into the street or alley.
- Lend a helping hand. Remove from your street gutters and alleys all trash and loose items that could potentially interfere with storm drainage.
