Discussion of Increased Flow to Franklin Regional Wastewater Treatment Center

Mr. Moore explained that the flow rates have increased by 5% above the estimated flow rate for 2019. He believes that several sump pumps throughout the city are being discharged into the sanitary sewer. Staff will be looking into solutions for this increase by educating the residents and informing them of the need for change.
