Business:

2018 Street Program

Mr. Wirrig and Mrs. Gilleland reviewed the proposed 2018 Street Program with Council. They explained the funding, bidding and what streets will be included. If Council plans to reinstate the tax credit, we will have to scale back on the streets included in the 2018 Program.

Discussion on Income Tax Credit

Council discussed the citizen's comments and suggestions regarding the income tax credit. Several visitors asked additional questions and made comments. The consensus of Council would be to place this topic on the next Work Session to review again. Staff was asked to have figures and suggestions on various ways to adjust the income tax credit reinstatement and the income tax rate that would provide approximately \$400,000.

Staff and Council discussed proposed Ordinance No. 18-04 regarding annual pay to honor guard participants and field training officers. Council agreed to consider the legislation.
