Germantown Stray Cat Advice

If you have a stray or feral cat issue, call the city offices for assistance. The City has a couple of different approaches to dealing with stray and feral cats. First, the City contracts with Montgomery County Animal Resource Center (ARC) to assist with stray and feral cat removal. The ARC will trap and remove stray cats. Secondly, Robyn's Nest animal rescue offers the option to "TNR" (trap-neuter-return). This method works to reduce the number of stray cats while being responsible in caring for their lives. There are many options for low cost or even free spays and neuters in Montgomery County. To alleviate stray cat issues, we recommend that you do not feed stray cats, make sure your porches are enclosed underneath, and no pet food or garbage is accessible.
