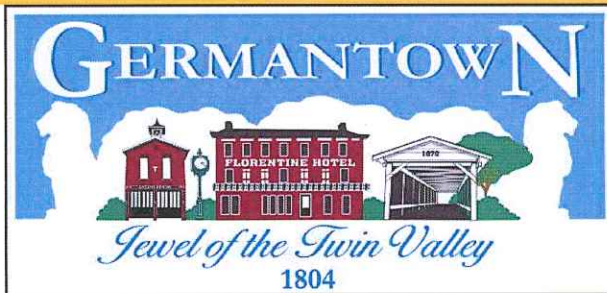

Let it Snow!

Snow removal is just around the corner. Just a few reminders to help our Service Department with the snow removal process:

1. Place curb markers to show plows the edge of your lawn or driveway
2. Whenever possible, use off street parking when snow accumulation is predicted
3. Set garbage and recycling cans behind the curb so to not interfere with plows
4. Snow cleared from your property should remain on your property

Plowing will result in snow at the end of your driveway; unfortunately, this is unavoidable and clearing the driveway is the property owner's responsibility. Plows will try to evenly distribute snow in cul-de-sacs when possible.
