RECOGNITION OF VISITORS:

Ashley Powell- representing Moms Made for a Mission, a none-profit organization. The organization wants to add a Little Free Library, in Veteran's Memorial park. The Little Free Library is a small weather proof box, where residents may take or place books for the use of the community. Currently there are no Little Free Libraries within a 20 mile radius. Moms Made for a Mission will accept responsibility of the expenses and maintenance in the project .

BUSINESS:

The Board discussed the options available for recommendation to the Council regarding the Park Levy and the November election.

- New Levy: An entirely new levy to be submitted on the ballot, with a new millage.(%) to be taxed against current property values. This would provide an increase to Park funds
- Renewal: Renews the current levy at the same millage(%)to be taxed against property values, as they were valued at time of the original levy. This will provide no increase to Park funds.
- Replacement Levy: Maintains the same millage(%) to be taxed against property values, but as they are valued today . This would provide an increase to the Park funds

Tyler Rehmert advised the Board he would meet with the City Finance Director to review the Parks financial needs. He will share this information with the Board at the next meeting, to assist in making their recommendation to the City Manager & Council.


